

URGENT BRIEFING NOTE

To:

The Honourable Ministers of the Queensland Government, the New South Wales Government, and the Australian Commonwealth Government, and relevant Shadow Ministers

Date: 3 August 2026

Subject: Urgent Ministerial Intervention Required – Systemic Failures Leading to Catastrophic and Ongoing Harm

I respectfully request urgent ministerial review and intervention in the matters set out below.

Lower-level departments across multiple jurisdictions have failed to correct, remedy or prevent serious wrongdoing that has produced cascading economic destruction, loss of property, loss of livelihood, and ongoing personal harm. These failures include the misuse of departmental powers that enabled the original wrongdoing and the subsequent refusal or inability of those same departments to reverse the resulting damage.

The matters now require Cabinet-level attention. Ordinary administrative channels have been exhausted. Continued inaction will cause further preventable harm and catastrophic irreparable loss.

For the detailed reasons why each request is appropriate, please refer to the attached Submissions, Affidavit and Evidence Bundle.

The following assignments are offered as a practical, layperson suggestion of the Ministers best placed to direct the relevant outcomes. Parliament may of course re-allocate as it sees fit. Relevant Shadow Ministers are noted for oversight and follow-up.

To the Hon Anika Wells MP, Minister for Communications, and the Hon Tony Burke MP, Minister for the Arts and Home Affairs; and to the relevant Shadow Ministers:

Remove Incitement to Violence Materials

- All Incitement Media Items Removed from Publication Immediately (see attached schedule of 15 links / public placements)
- Social Media profile access restored to retrieve hidden exculpatory evidence directly related to and supportive of these requests

To the Hon Tony Burke MP, Minister for Home Affairs and Minister for Immigration and Citizenship; Senator the Hon Penny Wong, Minister for Foreign Affairs; and Senator the Hon Jonathon Duniam, Shadow Minister for Home Affairs and Immigration (and relevant Shadow Foreign Affairs Minister):

Restore Travel Status

- Assist where appropriate in the current San Francisco Immigration Court proceedings to vacate the removal orders and terminate the political asylum application, so that US travel status can be fully restored.
- Make representations to the relevant United States counterparts (including the Executive Office for Immigration Review, the Department of Homeland Security, and the Department of Justice) requesting that the already-filed application to vacate be reviewed as a matter of urgency.
- Note that the original restrictions arose from Australian departmental failures. Continuing to restrict a talented Australian citizen's international movement because of those local failures is unfair, risks unnecessary friction in bilateral relations, and urgent action on the reopening would liberate the significant cultural and economic export value of the applicant's music and entertainment enterprises - particularly where the artist is transparently inviting ongoing guidance and review with Arts and Tourism Ministers and Secretaries in both Australia and the United States.
